Rules:

1. Weigh-in at 9:00-10:30a.m.
2. Registration starts at 9:00a.m.- 10:30a.m.
3. The officials have the right to reject or disqualify any entry. The judges' decision is final. Any arguing will also result in disqualification!
4. All weights must be safely & securely fastened to tractor. Anything falling off results in disqualification.
5. Front wheels of tractor must not rise to any unsafe height according to judge's discretion.
6. Maximum draw bar height is 20". Pinhole is 18" from center to axle. Anyone pulling a tractor with a 3 point hitch will be disqualified if draw bar height rises or changes position after start of pulling. Draw bar must be accessible. Puller must furnish own twistor pullers eye to accept eliminator hook or no hook. (minimum 3" hole t clevis) Pulling point can be no more than 1.5" from back edge of hitching device.
7. Tractor must stay within boundaries or it will be disqualified.
8. **ABSOLUTELY NO DRINKING BEFORE PULLING!!!!!!!!!!**
9. **TRACTORS MUST HAVE FENDERS THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!!!!!!**
10. Tractors must be 1958 or older stock farm tractors.
11. Draw bar height not to exceed 20".
12. Front weight **will not** extend ahead of front wheels more than 24" or 24" behind rear wheels. Weights must not interfere with the hookup. If anything breaks or falls off of the tractor, the tractor will be disqualified.
13. Pullers must furnish own twisted clevis or pullers eye to accept eliminator hook or no hook. (minimum 3" hole and no straight clevis) **Pulling point can be no more than 1.5" from back of hitching device.**
14. Driver must remain fully seated during entire pull and operate their tractor in a safe manner.
15. All contestants enter at their own risk and will sign a waiver. Anyone under 18 must show a tractor safety certificate and have a consent form signed by parent/guardian.
16. Tractors finishing in 2nd or 3rd are subject to re-weighing by \$10 request only. Money must be given to judges only.
17. You are allowed only ONE hook. (Subject to change)
18. **All tractors must be registered by 10:30a.m. Any late registrations will have to pay an extra \$5.00.**
19. Money and Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.
20. **NO HOT-RODDING WILL BE ACCEPTED, IT WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION!!!!!!**
21. You can not use TA's, will be exception to farm classes.
22. **Start time is at 11:00a.m. sharp!!!**
23. All Harrisville rules apply.
